

International Short Film Festival 2020

Rules & Guidelines

- 1) The aim of the Festival is to document the world order affected by Covid19 and to encourage aspiring film makers across the globe to undertake an artistic representation of the pandemic times. This Festival / Competition is open universally to all without any age limit.
- 2) The film should be based on a broad theme 'Sketching the Corona World'
- 3) There will be a separate section for the entries from Delhi-NCR, they will automatically there in the global competition too.
- 4) There will be two categories in the Competition Fiction & Non-Fiction.
- 5) Both categories will be for a maximum running duration of 10 minutes each in English, Hindi or Malayalam languages.
- 6) Non-Fiction can be news, interviews based features, documentary, poetic visualisation, photo features etc.
- 7) A person or a team can participate in the competition. One entry each will be allowed in both Fiction & Non-fiction categories. A separate entry form must accompany for each entry.
- 8) Best three productions will be selected for awards for First, Second and Third positions. Awards include Citation, Certificate and Cash prize of Rs.15,000/- for first position, Rs.10,000/- for 2nd position and Rs.5,000/- for 3rd position in each category globally.
- 9) Special awards comprising Citation and Certificates will be given to first three positions for the section of entries from Delhi-NCR.
- 10) If the jury select one or more winners for any/all of the above three positions, then the prize money will be shared equally between the winners.

- 11) Materials sending for the competition must be original and any dispute arising on copyright issue of the material (Audio, Video or any other materials) is the sole responsibility of the participant and the organisers will not take any responsibility in this regard.
- 12) Copyrights claims if noticed at any stage, those productions will be rejected without any intimation.
- 13) Any controversy or disputes on films will be sole responsibility of the respective production team/participant.
- 14) All entry forms / self declaration must be received on or before 15th July 2020 to email ID: jsshortfilm2020@gmail.com
- 15) The entry fee will be Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) for each entry in both categories. The payment link will be shared after receiving the entry form. The entry fee is not refundable or transferable at any circumstances.
- 16) Last date to submit the production is 31 July 2020. Entries must be sent to the following link:-

Entries received after 31st July 2020 will not be accepted.

17) The videos must be in the following format

Format : PAL Aspect Ratio : 16 : 9 Video Quality : HD

- 18) The submitted videos or other materials will be the property of Janasamskriti.
- 19) The submitted videos or other materials will not be returned at any circumstances.
- 20) The organizers of this International Short Film Festival reserves all rights to use all submitted promotional materials, including but not limited to film stills, descriptions, director's biography in any/all forms of media for the purpose of promotion and publicity of the Festival.
- 21) Janasamskriti / Selection Committee reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any film.
- 22) Any obscene subjects / contents will be rejected without any intimation.

- 23) The entry must also include the following: film description (50 words or less), complete list of production crew, head shot of the Director & the Photographer / Videographer (digital, 200 dpi min.), Director's bio-data, including list of previous and planned projects, and 3 stills from the film (digital, 200 dpi min.).
- 24) All the participants / teams must abide by the prevalent guidelines issued from time to time by the respective Governments in respect of Covid19 pandemic during their production activities. The organisers have no liability for any untoward incidents / consequences, whatsoever.
- 25) A Screening Committee will shortlist 10 best productions for final screening and the Jury comprising of experts in this field will select the best 3 productions in both Fiction & Non Fiction categories.
- 26) Participants will be notified of the status of their production after selection by the Screening Committee through email. Please make certain that the email address provided in the entry form is active and correct. You may add one alternate email ID with the entry form.
- 27) The decision of the Jury will be final and binding to all concerned.
- 28) Film makers of the selected 10 films for screening will be given opportunity to speak to audience at the end of their film screening.
- 29) The Screening will be through the FB Page and YouTube Channels of Janasamskriti.
